My Lord. Have the Honor to inform your Lordship, that this Day at Noon, the Burlings bearing S. E. 42 Leagues, I fell in with La Constance French Brig Privateer, belonging to Nantz, which I captured after a Chace of Five Hours; she is a remarkably fine Vessel, pierced for 18 Guns, but has only 12 Six and Nine-Pounders on Board, and 96 Men, Copper-Bottomed, quite new, fails very fast, and is only Ten Days from Nantz, on a Cruize off the Western Islands.
