A PROCLAMATION.

GEORGE, P. R.

WHEREAS the Parliament stands prorogued to Monday the first day of November next, We, in the name and on the behalf of His Majesty, and by and with the advice of His Majesty's Privy Council, do hereby publish and declare, that the said Parliament shall be further prorogued on the said first day of November next, to Thursday the fourth Day of said month; and We have given order to the Lord High Chancellor of that part of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland called Great Britain, to prepare a Commission for proroguing the same accordingly. And We do further hereby, in the name and on the behalf of His Majesty, and by and with the advice aforesaid, publish and declare, that the said Parliament shall, on the fourth day of November next, be held and sit for the dispatch of divers urgent and important affairs: And the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and the Knights, Citizens, and Burgesses, and the Commissioners for Shires and Burghs of the House of Commons, are hereby required and commanded to give their attendance accordingly, at Westminster, on the said fourth day of November next.

Given at the Court at Carlton-House, the twelfth day of September one thousand eight hundred and thirteen, in the fifty-third year of His Majesty's Reign.

IT is this day ordered by His Royal Highness the Prince Regent, in the name and on the behalf of His Majesty, and by and with the advice of His

Majesty's Privy Council, that His Grace the Lord Archbishop of Canterbury do prepare the Form of Prayer and Thanksgiving to Almighty God, for the abundant Harvest; to be read upon the first day of the General Thanksgiving, on Sunday the second day of October next, and to be continued until Sunday the seventeenth day of the same month exclusive: and it is hereby ordered, that His Majesty's Printer do forthwith print a sufficient number of the said Form of Prayer and Thanksgiving, that the same may be forthwith sent round and read as above directed, in the several Churches and Chapels throughout those parts of the United Kingdom called England and Wales.

IT is this day ordered, by His Royal Highness the Prince Regent in Council, in the name and on the behalf of His Majesty, that every Minister or Preacher, as well of the established Church as that part of Great Britain called Scotland, as those of the Episcopal Communion, be protected and allowed by an Act passed in the tenth year of Her late Majesty Queen Anne, cap. 7, intituled, "An Act to prevent the disturbing noise of the Episcopal Communion, in that part of Great Britain called Scotland, in the exercise of their religious worship, and in the use of the Liturgy of the Church of England," and for repealing an Act passed in the Parliament of Scotland, intituled "An Act against Irregular Baptisms and Marriages," do at some time during the exercise of the divine service, in such respective Church, congregation or assembly, on Sunday the second and next Sunday the seventeenth of October next inclusive, or from the first Sunday until the second
