- The Wild Birds Protection (County of Kent) Order, 1902.

Dated 3rd April, 1902.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred on me by the Wild Birds Protection Acts, 1880 to 1896, and upon application by the County Council of the Administrative County of Kent, I hereby make the following Order :-

Title.

f. This Order may be cited as "The Wild Birds Protection (County of Kent) Order, 1902."

BIRDS.

Extension of Close Time throughout the County.

II. The time during which the killing or taking of Wild Birds is prohibited by the Act of 1880, shall, except as regards the Common Wild Duck, te extended throughout the County of Kent, so as to be between the 1st day of March and the 13th day of August in each year,

Certain Birds protected during the whole of the Year.

111. During the period between the 12th day of August in any year and the 2nd day of March August in any year and the 2nd day of March following, the taking or killing of any of the following kinds of Wild Birds is prohibited throughout the County of Kent:--Nightingale, Goldfinch, Nightjar, Woodpeckers, Kingfisher, Cuckoo, Owls, Kestrel, Buzzard, Honey Buzzard, Merlin, Hobby, Osprey, Wryneck (Cuckoo's Mate or Snake Bird) Swallow Marting (2) Swift Merlin, Hobby, Osprey, Wryneck (Cuckoo's Mate or Snake Bird), Swallow, Martins (2), Swift, Bearded Tit, Iongtailed Tit, Nuthatch, Wren, Reedling or Reed Pheasant, Shrikes, Wheatear, Bittern, Stonechat, Whinchat, Redstart, Fly-catchers, Sedge Warbler, Reed Warbler, Black Cap, Garden Warbler, Wood Warbler, Willow Warbler, Chiffchaff, Whitethroat, Lesser White-throat, Golden-crested Wren, Wagtails (4), Buntings (3) Robin Buntings (3), Robin.

All Birds protected on Sundays in certain Parishes.
