(Nos. 2 and 4), dated the twenty-fourth day of July, and the eighth day of August, nineteen hundred and eleven, respectively, shall cease to operate with respect to the Scheduled District No. II.

Commencement.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the sixteenth day of August, nineteen hundred and eleven.

3. This Order may be cited as the East Sussex and Kent (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) ORDER OF 1911 (No. 5).
