WELFARE OF WORKERS IN FACTORIES AND WORKSHOPS.

The Secretary of State gives notice, that on the 28th July, 1920, he made an Order (to come into force on the 1st September, 1920) under Section 7 of the Police, Factories, &c. (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 1916, for securing the welfare of the workers employed in factories or workshops or parts thereof in which the processes of gut-scraping and gut-washing, and processes incidental thereto, or the preparing and dressing of tripe, are carried on. The Order will not apply to any factory or workshop in which such processes are only occasionally carried on.
