Act, 1920, the London Electric and City and South London Companies Act, 1922, and other Acts and Orders applying to the before mentioned Companies, and to apply to the purposes of the intended Act certain public Acts, with or without modifications.

#### RUNCORN DISTRICT WATER BOARD.

NOTICE is hereby given, that application is intended to be made to Parliament in the ensuing Session for an Act for all or some of the purposes indicated in the following short statement of the principal subject-matters of the Bill (that is to say):—For the constitution and incorporation of a Water Board (hereinafter referred to as "the Board"), consisting of representatives of or appointed by the Runcorn Urban District Council and the Runcorn Rural District Council; provisions with reference to the Board; power to acquire the whole or part of the water undertaking of the Runcorn Urban District Council; transfer of undertaking; terms and conditions relating thereto; payments by Board; limits of supply to include the urban district of Runcorn and the parishes of Clifton, Halton and Weston, in the rural district of Runcorn; maintenance of works; new works with approval of Ministry of Health; abstraction of waters; acquisition of and powers as to lands and easements; protection of waterworks and water supplies; cancellation of agreements, including an agreement between the constituent authorities dated the 5th April, 1905; communication pipes, etc.; breaking-up of roads, etc.; powers to consumers; rates, charges and terms and conditions; general provisions as to supply of water; bulk supply; meters, fittings, etc.; prevention of waste, etc.; entry on consumer's premises; borrowing of money; application to Board of powers of an urban sanitary authority under the Public Health Acts and other Acts; agreements; byelaws and regulations; repeal, amendment, extension and incorporation of Acts; cancellation and amendment of agreements, etc.

Printed copies of the Bill for the intended Act will be deposited in the Private Bill Office of the House of Commons on or before the 16th day of December next.
