

(Made-up Textiles) Order, 1920, and by the Trade Boards (Rope, Twine and Net and Drift Nets) Order, 1925, **HEREBY GIVE NOTICE** that they **PROPOSE TO VARY** the General Minimum Time-Rates and Piece-Work Basis Time-Rates for all female workers and the Overtime Rates based thereon and the General Minimum Piece-Rates for female Home-workers for Hand Braiding, Hand Knotting or Hand Baiting Nets made from fibres other than hard fibres and the Overtime Rates for female workers (other than Home-workers) employed on Hand Machine Braiding to whom the General Minimum Piece-Rates fixed by the Trade Board for Hand Machine Braiding are applicable, at present effective and set out in the Schedule to the Trade Board's Notice B. (42) dated 19th November, 1925.
