Maurice Childs, Chiswick, W.4.

On the 29th March, 1939, Mr. Childs located on Hammersmith Bridge a suitcase containing explosive and burning fuse, and, at grave risk, threw it into the river where it exploded. Two separate charges had been placed on the bridge. With considerable presence of mind and fine disregard of danger, Mr. Childs prevented one explosion taking effect, and this greatly minimised the damage to the structure.
