The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that they have made an Order under section 203 of the Customs and Excise Act, 1952, viz:—The Hydrocarbon Oil Duties (Drawback) (No. 2) Order, 1960.

This Order varies the rates used for determining the quantities of hydrocarbon oil in respect of which drawback is allowed as respects the classes or descriptions of articles specified in the Schedule. It also withdraws the provision for drawback in respect of 3-hydroxy-2-naphtho-m-nitroanilide.

The Order comes into operation on 30th August 1960, and has been published as Statutory Instruments 1960, No. 1531.

This Order provides that certain products of the chemical and allied industries, and certain key-opening collar cans, shall be temporarily exempted from import duty.
