Conditions attaching to Licence A

A. 1. Each consignment must be accompanied by a certificate signed by a duly authorised veterinary officer of the Government of the exporting country stating that:

(a) The meat/offal is derived from animals slaughtered in an abattoir licensed for the production of meat for human consumption.

(b) The meat/offal is derived from animals which received veterinary ante- and post-mortem inspection by an Official Veterinary Surgeon and showed no evidence of any of the diseases listed in Annex E of EEC Directive 64/432 on animal health problems affecting intra-Community trade in bovine animals and swine.

(c) The meat/offal has not been obtained from animals which come from a holding or area which for health reasons is subject to prohibition pursuant to Article 3(2)(b) of EEC Directive 64/432, as a result of an outbreak of foot-and-mouth disease.
