

## TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act, which will authorise the stopping-up of Hicks Lane, Coulston Lane, Cross Love Street and lengths of Spring Street and Love Lane, Sheffield.

If the Order is made, the stopping-up will be authorised only in order to enable the development described in the Schedule to this notice to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted to PSA Services by Sheffield City Council, on 16th November 1992, under ref. 92/0013P.

Copies of the draft Order and relevant plan may be inspected at all reasonable hours during the 28 days commencing on 2nd February 1993, at the Administration and Legal Department, City of Sheffield Metropolitan District Council, Town Hall, Sheffield and may be
