WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981: SECTION 29

The Leek Moors-Bareleg Hill (Staffordshire) Nature Conservation Revocation Order 1994

Whereas the Secretary of State made the Leek Moors-Bareleg Hill (Staffordshire) Nature Conservation Order 1990 ("the 1990 Order") which took effect when it was made on 11th July 1990.

The Nature Conservancy Council for England (English Nature) has since the Order secured the protection of the land described in that Order by the conclusion of a management agreement with the landowner:
