THE BARNET (PRESCRIBED ROUTE) (NO 1) TRAFFIC ORDER 2006

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Barnet have made on 26 January 2006, the above-mentioned Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers.

The general effect of the Order will be to make permanent the provisions of The Barnet (Prescribed Route) (No 3) Experimental Traffic Order 2004, which introduced on an experimental basis various compulsory or banned vehicle movements around the Artsdepot development at Tally Ho Corner N12.
