*The Trunk Road (Mamhilad, Gwent)*  
*(Prohibition of Right-hand Turn) Order 1977*

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales has made an Order under Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which is to prohibit the making of a right-hand turn from that length of the Newport-Shrewsbury Trunk Road (A4042) at Mamhilad in the County of Gwent, into the unclassified road, which lies south-east of the Mamhilad Road, leading to Little Brick Works at its junction with the said Trunk Road.

A copy of the Order, together with a plan and statement of reasons for making the Order, may be seen during normal office hours, at the offices of the Torfaen Borough Council, Town Hall, Pontypool; and the Gwent County Council, Victoria Street, Cwmbran.

Copies of the Order may be obtained free of charge, on application to the Secretary of State, Welsh Office (Y Swyddfa Gymreig), Transport and Highways Group, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Cardiff, CF4 5PL, quoting the reference WR15/3/54.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks of the 24th November 1977 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.
